- Report all hazards and incidents to the Site Co-ordinator
- Dispose of waste appropriately
- Observe and obey all warning signs and instructions.
- · Report any injuries and get first aid promptly.
- Be prepared for likely weather conditions.
- Refrain from consuming alcohol while taking part in work parties.
- Receive a copy of this Plan
