DRAYTON RESERVE PLANTING SPECIFICATION 2016

- 1. Set out stakes in positions to be planted.
- 2. Place seedlings beside stakes on the day.
- 3. Lift stake and clear ground 2x2 spade widths.
- 4. Level sloping ground like a dish (to hold water).
- 5. Dig hole deeper than pottle (to get roots as deep as possible for moisture).
- 6. Squeeze pottle and pull out seedling.
- 7. Tease out tangled roots but don't loose too much potting mix.
- 8. Place into hole and lightly press soil back into hole around roots.
- 9. Replace stake near S/W side of plant (can find seedling easier in long grass if stake is found and can tie plant if vulnerable to strong S/W wind)
- 10. Mulch ground around seedling with cleared grass.
- 11. Put empty pottle/bag on stake (to show that stake has a plant).
