

## DRAYTON RESERVE PLANTING SPECIFICATION 2016

1. Set out stakes in positions to be planted.
2. Place seedlings beside stakes on the day.
3. Lift stake and clear ground 2x2 spade widths.
4. Level sloping ground like a dish (to hold water).
5. Dig hole deeper than pottle (to get roots as deep as possible for moisture).
6. Squeeze pottle and pull out seedling.
7. Tease out tangled roots but don't lose too much potting mix.
8. Place into hole and lightly press soil back into hole around roots.
9. Replace stake near S/W side of plant (can find seedling easier in long grass if stake is found and can tie plant if vulnerable to strong S/W wind)
10. Mulch ground around seedling with cleared grass.
11. Put empty pottle/bag on stake (to show that stake has a plant).
